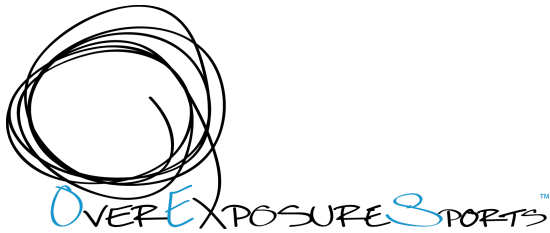
This Notice contains important information about our use of Cookies, what they are, the cookies we use and what you can do to manage them. Please read it carefully to understand how we use your personal information.

1. What are Cookies?

A cookie is a small text file that is saved to your computer by your web browser, and in that text file is some simple data, like your current session identifier. Information provided by cookies can help us to analyse the use of our sites and help us to provide you with a better user experience and allow our shopping cart to function properly.

Cookies are described as either 'session' or 'persistent' cookies, depending on the duration they are stored. Session cookies are only stored for the duration of your visit to a website and are deleted from your device when you close your browser; while persistent cookies are saved on your device for a fixed period of time after the browser has closed and are activated each time you visit the website where the cookie was generated.

If cookies aren't enabled on your computer, some aspects of our website will be limited, for example it will mean that your shopping experience on our website will be limited to browsing and researching; you won't be able to add products to your basket or buy them.

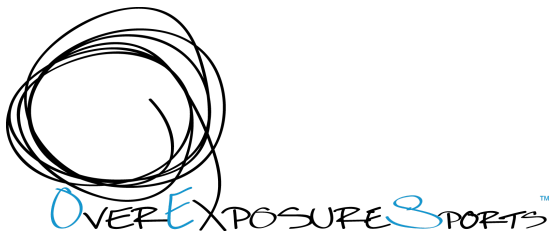
2. Cookies We Use

Google Analytics	These cookies are used to collect information about how visitors use our site. We use the information to compile reports and to help us improve the site. The cookies collect information in an anonymous form, including the number of visitors to the site, where visitors have come to the site from and the pages they visited.	Persistent Google's Privacy Policy can be found here We keep analytics information for 14 months from your last activity on our site.

4. Keeping Track of the Cookies we use

We will undertake a yearly audit to keep track of the cookies associated with our site and update this policy accordingly.

5. Managing and Opting Out of Cookies

If you would prefer to opt out of cookies, it is possible to do so by following the steps below, but you are reminded that you may lose some features and functionality of our website if you do so.

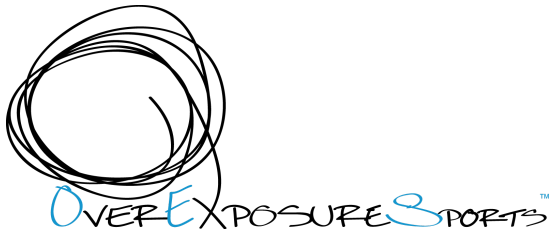
